<p>65.1</p>	<p>The committee discussed the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Matt is currently looking into a range of appropriate platforms to host the virtual festival. • Various platforms were discussed like Zoom, Facebook and YouTube for live streaming. • Matt is looking into Camera / Videoing, as he can do basic editing. Also, looking into the price of purchasing a camera to record the introductions for the Parish Councillors. • Scheduling the download of videos received from residents. • Linking up with various organisations / establishments to get some ideas on how to download data. • How long will the entire festival last? - maybe a couple of hours. • The content and who could potentially participate. The following names were suggested – Corona Hero’s, Better Bretton, Cllr Lee (quiz) and Cllr Chaz Fenner, as he does a radio show. Also, Helena the local vicar. • Looking into the logistics of the order and how it will be presented. • Allocated slot time = 5 minutes. • Suggested theme name “Bretton Got Talent” • Date of the festival - either 10th or 17th July 2021. <p><u>Overall, the committee agreed the following proposal.</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Matt will oversee the project with the support and assistance of the other members of the committee. • The theme name is “Bretton Got Talent”, and the date of the festival is <u>17th July 2021.</u> • Each participant will have a 5-minute slot. • Corona Hero’s – J Lee will contact him to see if they would like to support this project and do a 5-minute slot. • Helena Pino and Better Bretton – Clerk will ask them if they are willing to support the project and do a 5-minute slot. • Cllr Chaz Fenner – Cllr Mary Ann is going to ask him if he would support this project and do a 5-minute slot. • All Parish Councillors will be asked to do a 2-minute introduction session about themselves which will be screened at the opening of the festival. Matt will advise the Councillors on what to do. • In respect of the logistics, residents will produce a 5-minute video of their performance for Bretton Got Talent and send it to the Clerk no later than 12th June 2021. All data will be forwarded to Matt by 17th June 2021. This will then give him enough time to work on the editing for the festival on <u>17th July 2021.</u>
