He is working with PECT to look at an installation of a ghost playground. He stated that he will update the Parish Council when he has more information, it is a City Council project. Resolved: Cllr Ellis stated that this may be something the Parish Council could become involved with and asked Cllr Burbage for more information when it is available.
