1.1	Apologies had been received from J Merrill (technical issues)
1.2	Resolved: that the apologies be accepted.

6	<u>Planning Applications – to include</u>
6.1	20/00387HHFUL – Single storey extension in Manton – Cllr Rudd stated that this extension would change the vernacular of the area and as such was not in keeping with the rest of the street. Resolved: Objections to be raised as agreed by the committee.
6.2	20/00390HHFUL – Single storey extension in Ringwood – Resolved: No comments to make.

	6.3	20/00452HHFUL – Removal of conservatory and extensions – Hyholmes. Resolved: No comments to make.
	7	Car Parking Project - to receive an update and to discuss way forward
	7.1	The parking survey took place. Surveys had been collected and Cllr Strangward is in possession of the completed surveys, these will be discussed when formal meetings resumed. Given the current Government guidelines on social distancing and the present situation regarding Covid-19 it was agreed that this item and further surveys will be held in abeyance.
	8	Dog waste bins
	8.1	A report that there was a lack of adequate dog bins on Deerleap Green had been received. It was discussed that Bretton was lacking in dog bins, particularly around Bretton field. It was noted that bins were consistently vandalised and burnt down. It was also discussed that City Council funding may not stretch to replacement bins as there had been some concerns over the funding of replacement benches. Cllr Fenner said that he had been in contact with people regarding dog bins and bins in general. Resolved: Cllr Fenner will source some prices of replacement bins and that this item will remain on the agenda for the future so that further discussion and updates could take place. This matter may not be resolved until current Government restrictions are lifted.
